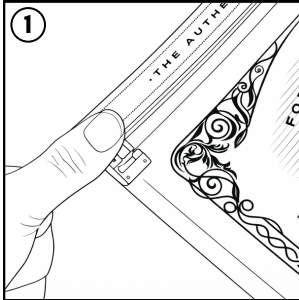
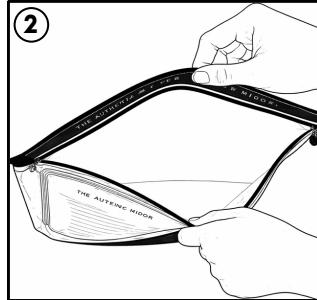


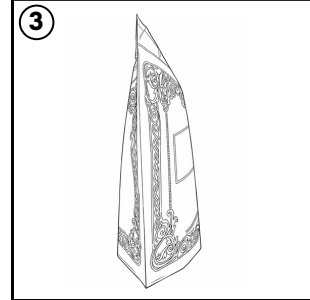
GETTING STARTED



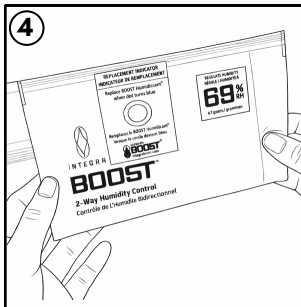
Place your finger on the fingerprint pad and push the zipper pull forward to open. The zipper pull rests inside the pad, which is anchored to the bag.



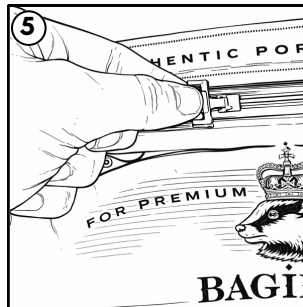
Remove the included contents. Spread out the expandable bottom to fully open the bag.



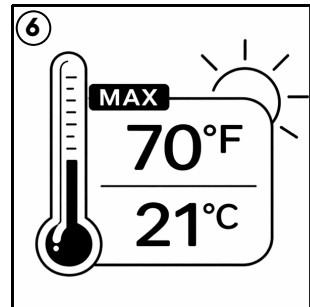
Load cigars. Don't overfill the top section. Leave enough space to keep the opening flat and even. If a gap forms, remove a few cigars.



Remove the humidity pack and indicator card from the plastic sleeve and place inside BAGIDOR.



Keep both sides of the zipper flat and aligned, then gently pull the zipper across to close. Do not force the zipper closed.



Cigars are best stored between 65-70°F (18-21°C)

HUMIDOR USE AND CARE

ZIPPER CARE

Do not overfill the top section. Ensure both sides of the zipper are flat and aligned before closing. The zipper should close smoothly and easily; never force it closed.

HUMIDITY PACK

Place the 2-way humidity pack on, under, or between cigars. Do not open, cut, or puncture the humidity pack. Allow 24-72 hours for the internal humidity to fully stabilize. Replace the humidity pack every three months.

CAPACITY

Holds up to 40 cigars. Expand the bottom of the BAGIDOR for maximum capacity.

STORAGE

Lay flat for long-term storage, and rotate cigars every 2-3 months.

PROTECTION

Avoid prolonged heat (direct sun, hot cars). Do not submerge in water, and avoid crushing, bending, or folding the bag.
